Who is Entitled to Obtain a Certified Copy of a Death Certificate?

You will be asked to show documentation, in order to establish that you have a right to the record, in addition to your photo identification. The chart below lists who is eligible and how to establish that relationship. Please bring original documents with raised seal.

<u>IF YOU ARE THE:</u> <u>YOU WILL NEED TO SHOW:</u>

CHILD Your birth certificate with your parents' names on it;

marriage license if you are married to address your

name change

GRANDCHILD Your birth certificate with parents' names and your

parents' birth (or death) certificates with their parents (your grandparents) names showing; your marriage license if you are married to address your name

change

CURRENT SPOUSE Your marriage license

SIBLING Your birth certificate with your parents' names

showing; marriage license if you are married to

address your name change

EX-SPOUSE NOT entitled unless you are obtaining same on behalf

of a minor child – minor child's birth certificate with

parents' names showing

If you have remarried, you must bring your current marriage license to address the name change

EXECUTOR of Valid Surrogate's Certificate with original signature

and seal

STEP-CHILD NOT entitled
